HIS EARLY LIFE

Apostle Emmanuel Atta Adade and his twin sister were born in Kumasi Ghana, West Africa to Mr. Lawrence Emmanuel Kwesi Adade (Aka Lakka), who was then the Manager for United African Company (UAC) and Madam Grace Adwoa Pokua, a trader in Kumasi Asafo Market on Sunday, 21st of March, 1971. Emmanuel Adade, together with his siblings were raised in one of the most tranquil suburbs in Kumasi, Asokwa. The early years of Apostle Emmanuel Adade were marked by peaceful transitions from childhood through adolescence to his adult life.

Apostle Emmanuel Adade grew up in a disciplined and spiritually healthy environment. His father was a staunch presbyterian and his

mother, a member of the Church of Pentecost, Ghana. As characteristic of him, young Emmanuel Adade used to follow his mother to Church on Sundays. His mother became his first mentor by occasionally engaging him to read the scriptures for her after Church because she was uneducated. This practice made him develop love and passion for the Word of God right from his early stages.

SCHOOL LIFE

Emmanuel Adade started his basic education at St. Benedict Preparatory School in Kumasi, Asafo. He proceeded to Amankwatia Experimental School, Kumasi, Asokwa. Later on, he pursued his secondary education at T.I Ahmadiyya Secondary School. He was a brilliant student. He was known on campus to be one of the best students, academically.

Whilst pursuing his secondary education as a General Science student at the T.I Ahmadiyya Secondary School, Kumasi, his spiritual hunger for the things of God began to grow and kept increasing. It was at that time that he met his campus friends: Victor

Kusi Boateng (prophet), Albert Ennin (of blessed memory), Apostle Charles Dedu, Frank Bonsu, Prophet Lawrence Owusu Ansah, among a tall list of firebrands who finally came together to form a student group called The Youth Evangelistic Ministry (YEM). The group used to meet at a popular uncompleted administration block on campus called “The Slaughter House”. Every meeting attracted a lot of souls, backed by miracles, signs and wonders. In 1991, Emmanuel Adade completed his Advanced Level education.

Growing up, Apostle Emmanuel Adade had a childhood dream of becoming a gynecologist. As a brilliant science student, he worked hard to pursue this dream. However, his passion, zeal and love for God’s work kept increasing after his A’ Level education. Having received a number of divine encounters, some from men of God, he gave his new stapes with contemplative thoughts. As a shy and reserved person, he had doubts about these prophecies because he did not have the ability to even stand before



a large group of people. In the process of time, the call of God upon his life became so intense that he finally gave up his dream of pursuing medicine at the university. To him, everyone must follow their pursuit, and not necessarily following others' opinion, no matter how great it may be.

In seeking for further clarification, he embarked on a two-week prayer and fasting. Within that period, he had a supernatural encounter with the Lord and requested that God sends someone to confirm his

calling. He attended the normal prayer meeting just after his two-week encounter with the Lord and one of his friends, Prophet Lawrence Owusu Ansah reaffirmed Emmanuel Adade's decision of entering into the ministry. The Prophet specifically told him that he (Emmanuel Adade) had a conversation with the Lord and he (Prophet Lawrence Owusu Ansah) had been sent to confirm to him that it is surely the Lord's will for Emmanuel Adade to fully respond to the call of God. That day marked

MARRIAGE AND FAMILY LIFE

Apostle Emmanuel Adade got married to his best friend, Mercy Afriyie Donkor (now, Rev. Mrs. Mercy Afriyie Adade) at Calvary Charismatic Centre (CCC), Kumasi, on 27th May, 1995. Their marriage ceremony was officiated by Rev. Ransford Obeng, the senior pastor of CCC. By grace, their marriage is blessed with five children: Evelyn, Emmanuel, Kezia, Kelvina and Kirsten.

HIS MINISTERIAL MANDATE

At the beginning, he faced lots of

challenges when he declared his intention to respond to the call of God on his life. At the initial stages, no one in his family, including his father and some of his friends, accepted that he entered into ministry. To them, Adade was a brilliant person who could do so well and advance progressively on the academic ladder. Due to this mix-up on the part of his immediate family, he was kicked out from the house by his father for charting the path of ministry. He took to the streets and had to start living in other people's homes while doing his A' Level national service at Asokwa -Amakom Junior High School. He however, remained resolute and determined to pursue the call of God for his life. As part of pursuing the purpose of God for his life, he married and settled

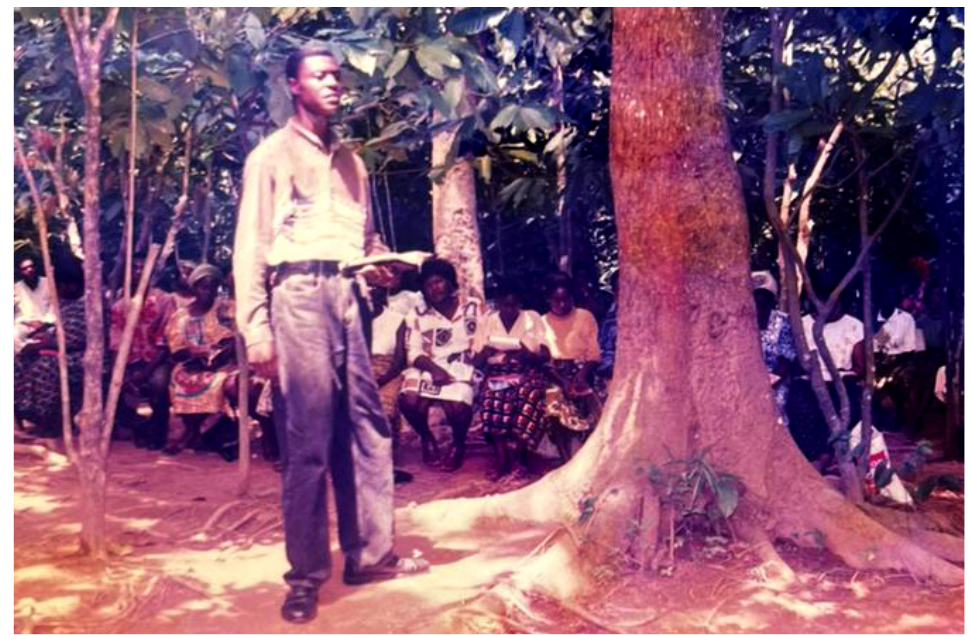


down with his wife Rev. Mrs. Mercy Afriyie Adade.

As a newly connubial couple, Apostle Adade and his wife (Mercy) started praying together to seek for God's direction concerning their marriage and ministry. On one of their honeymoon prayer meetings, the Lord revealed Himself to him (Adade) in a vision. In that vision, he saw himself and his wife situated by a big pool where a lot of people had come for them to wash and clean them up. Most of these people were very dirty. He saw that some were also kept down at the base of the pool and the debris under

the pool had made them relatively dirty. In that vision, he saw that he was pulling them out of the pool to wash them whilst his wife also cleaned them up.

To his amazement, he saw, for the first time, a white long Limousine wagon that came to pick up the people after they had been washed and cleaned. The car moved the people to a big shopping mall where they were clothed and dressed up properly. In the vision, the Lord spoke to him clearly and said, "I am calling you to



become the Repairer of the Bridge". This revelation birthed the Glorious Zion Missions International and Emmadade Outreach Ministry.

Apostle Emmanuel Adade and Rev. Mrs. Mercy Adade his wife were led by the Lord to Obuasi to start a ministry after they rejected an offer move to the United Kingdom to start a branch of a denomination. Ministering in Obuasi was tough at the beginning but the Lord saw them through. Due to financial constraints, they couldn't rent a place for church services or even rent a room. His wife had to 'perch' with a lady friend whilst he(Adade) stayed with a friend. They quickly organized



some prayer meetings at The Golf Park in Obuasi under a cocoa farm. The prayer meeting started growing fast in numbers and the Lord helped them to secure a classroom at Salvation Army school, Obuasi where the church officially took off in 1995.

The couple also used to organize a monthly revival programme dubbed The Tent Meeting at a particular location in the Obuasi township, where a lot of people were brought together. Highly anointed men of God like Prophet Opoku Nsiah, Prophet Lawrence, Prophet Philip Boadi, Prophet Noah Nyamekye, Prophet Victor Kusi Boateng, among other leading servants of God were brought into the city of Obuasi to be blessing to the lives of the people through the teaching of the Word of God and the demonstration of God's power to set captives free. The Tent programme had more than 500 to 700 people in attendance.

While running the church at the Salvation Army school, the monthly revival Tent Programme was also ongoing. There were lots of challenges at their official meeting place so they had to find another place for their services. After consistent search, the Lord gave

them a place; The Miners' Dinner. This was the dining space for AngloGold Ashanti Expatriate which had been closed down for almost two years. For years, The Miners' Dinner was their meeting place until the Lord made a way for Apostle Emmanuel Adade and his leadership team to own their land at the Ridge Community in Obuasi. Finally, the dream of building a multi-purpose

auditorium was realised. This is The Glorious Dome where they currently meet for church service.

Apostle Adade always believed in the social gospel, which promotes reaching out to the lost through material and financial assistance as demonstrated by the Lord Jesus Christ. Through his philanthropic project called “Hands of Hope”, he fed, clothed, sheltered and provided assistance for the needy but intelligent children in the society to pursue higher education. Together with his medical team, they also visited deprived rural communities to provide free health care and educated them on various health related issues.

Currently, through his able leadership, an Annual International Conference dubbed “Conquest Conference” is held, which is targeted at refining and equipping corporate leaders, church workers and believers for excellence in life and ministry.

Emmanuel Adade is acknowledged in the Christian community as an apostle and a highly respected minister of the Gospel.

He has been an inexhaustible and an exclusive preacher, mentor, conference speaker, author and a philanthropist. He has trained and mentored many pastors and leaders across the globe. Furthermore, over the past two decades, he raised a lot of young entrepreneurs who are doing exploits in their various fields of endeavour.

HIS LEGACY AND IMPACT

Emmadade Outreach Ministries (E.O.M.), headquartered in the United States of America is an outreach ministry to change and impact the world through the dynamic power of our Lord and Saviour Jesus Christ. Consisting of preaching and teaching the gospel of Jesus Christ through conventions, crusades, revivals and conferences, many lives have been touched and blessed.

At Emmadade Outreach Ministries (E.O.M), his crafted vision has been “possessing our possessions”. The focus is to concentrate on bringing deliverance and the liberating truth



of the Gospel of Jesus Christ to many. Through this ministry, the oppressed, rejected, abandoned, forsaken, those in darkness and the marginalized have found hope, peace, even as their immediate needs have also been met.

Aside, the E.O.M, which ministers to the spiritual needs of people, Emmanuel Adade established the Emmadade International Foundation (EMIF) as a branch of Emmadade

Outreach ministries which has the objective of ministering and spreading the good news of salvation as well as providing, as much as possible, some physical needs such as clothing and food to the needy in our society. Another primary target of the foundation is to provide a livelihood for those who are ministered to at their crusades.

A huge task placed on the heart of the visionary, Apostle Emmanuel Adade was to build a 50-acre Free Vocational Training Centre called The City of Hope in Obuasi, Ghana West Africa. To Emmanuel Adade, it was not enough to simply share God's love only in word. A complementary supportive system as the EMIF, by God's help and grace, seeks to fulfil this vision as given by God and even go beyond the expected by equipping those who are privileged with strength, to work and take care of their basic needs.

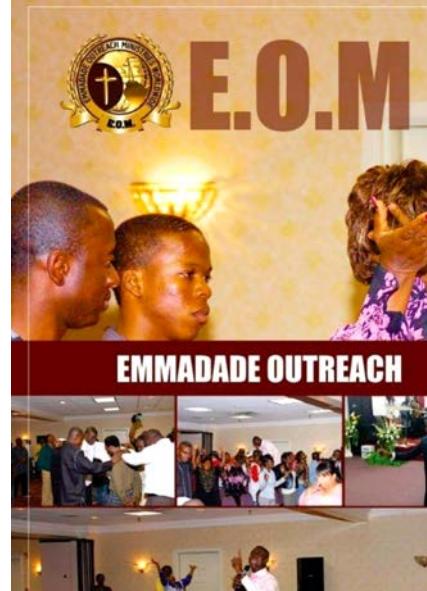

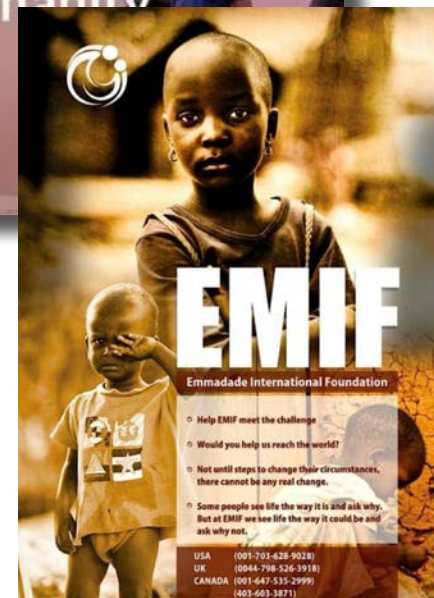
Until his demise, his dream had been to put up a rehabilitation facility to help integrate drug addicts and other social miscreants into our society.
