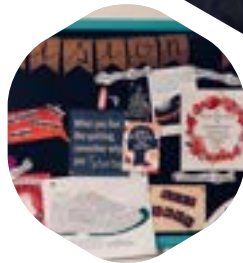

“Inspiration is not the receiving of information but the application of the information that was received” - Derek Sivers.

According to Newton’s first law of motion, a body will remain at rest or continue at a constant velocity unless a force is applied. Nothing would move, make progress, develop, or change position unless impacted by force. Such a force is likened to the inspiration needed for

the seed of greatness to transform into greatness itself.

In the last edition of the prophetic magazine, greatness and the seed were explored in-depth to provide a basic understanding. The main point was that inspiration was a requirement for the manifestation of greatness. And while the seed of greatness is within each of us, not everyone would eventually become great.

For a typical seed to transform into a tree, it must go through different stages of change before becoming a tree. One of the primary stages

towards greatness is called inspiration. The seed of greatness is dormant until it collides with inspiration.

What is Inspiration?

Archbishop Benson Idahosa of blessed memory once defined inspiration as in-spirit-I-on, literally meaning "in spirit, I rely on". The implication of this is that one depends on the supernatural for ideas in the natural. However, the word inspiration comes from the Latin word *inspirare*, which means to breathe into or inspire. In literal English, it means

"the drawing of air into the lungs". Although the orthodox meaning of inspiration centres around breathing, there is another distinctly theological meaning, referring to a divine influence upon a person from a divine entity.

Definitions of inspiration according to www.dictionary.com are as follows:

a: divine influence or action on a person believed to qualify them to receive and communicate sacred revelation

b: the action or power of moving the intellect or emotions

c: the act of influencing or suggesting opinions

It does not matter what inspiration means today and what it implies. The word is used in diverse contexts to mean various things. One notion that has stood the test of time is that inspiration flows from beyond the natural into a

natural being resulting in excellent outcomes.

This brings to remembrance the activities of the creation of man as recorded in Genesis 2:7, “Then the Lord God formed the man from the dust of the ground. He breathed the breath of life into the man’s nostrils, and the man became a living being.” This picture here is of a body with the potential to become a living man but was dormant until inspired by the breath of God into its purpose. Hence it became a living being.

The year 2022, as declared by the Holy Spirit through his servant Prophet Richard Amoaye, is the year of the supernatural. 2022 is the year that divinity will interact with humanity to produce extraordinary or supernatural results. Inspiration for the supernatural result would be made effective through diverse means, some of which will be through hearing and seeing. Based on the preceding, one can safely infer that inspiration could take place through sound and vision.

What is Vision?

In orthodox English, vision denotes a supernatural apparition. Notwithstanding, the word originated from the French word “videre” through the Latin

word “visio”, which means to see.

Definitions according to www.lexico.com pens vision as:

1. *The faculty or state of being able to see.*
2. *The ability to think about or plan the future with imagination or wisdom.*
3. *An experience of seeing someone or something in a dream or trance or as a supernatural apparition.*
4. *A vivid mental image, especially a fanciful one of the future.*

Even the dictionary definition of vision contains a supernatural component. Vision is not just seeing with your eyes but making sense of what you see—and perceiving a pathway or an answer in that which you see. The world is full of questions and challenges. And one of the ways the creator has made for the created beings to find answers

is through inspiration via visions. So, whatever you see must provide solutions and results to be a vision. In other words, a vision must become an inspiration for the realization of a particular goal. The scriptures conclude that; without a vision, the people will perish (Proverb 39:18). Therefore, the continuity of the human race is dependent on vision.

The Dynamics of Vision and Inspiration

Prophet Richard Amoaye explained vision dynamics in the process of supernatural inspiration for greatness. In 2 Kings 6:17 “, And Elisha prayed, open his eyes, Lord, so that he may see.” Then the Lord opened the servant’s eyes, and he looked and saw the hills full of horses and chariots of fire all around Elisha”.

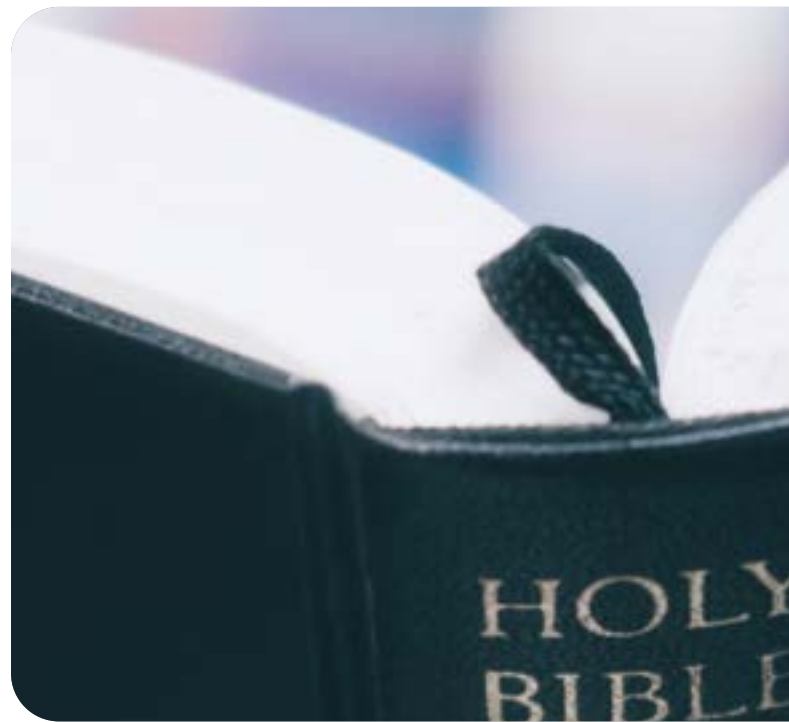
This was the story of Prophet Elisha, who though a prophet yet was an extraordinary defence/strategic adviser to the King of Israel – (2 Kings 6:12, 7:1).

Here was Elisha’s servant wondering about the source of his master’s confidence in the midst of life-threatening challenges. In common parlance, the servant could have asked what the secret was. Elisha’s response was simple but very profound- Lord, open his eyes that he may see.

From one of the many teachings of Prophet

Amoaye, the business of a prophet is to secure from the ancient archives of the supernatural latent information through sight, sounds and symbols for the benefit of humanity.

In the story in question, Elisha was getting security information, through sights and sounds, for the defence



of God’s people. He was also aware of heaven’s security provisions in his interest through supernatural sight. His access to the supernatural through what he could see gave him an advantage over a whole army. Elisha could not only see but was able to translate what he saw into tangible results for the benefit of society. His vision was able to save his community from being invaded and destroyed. While Prophet Richard Amoaye was ministering at the beginning of the year, he revealed that in 2022, inspirations that would produce results would depend on what can be seen. The question is, what can you see?

Going back in history, when Sir Isaac Newton was a freshman at the University of Cambridge, he found it difficult to cope with his studies. Two years later, when

a pandemic broke out, he was forced to take a break from the university. It was during this break and while walking in an orchard that he saw an apple fall from a tree onto the ground. Like many others, there was nothing spectacular about an apple falling from a tree. However, when Newton saw that apple fall, he thought about the forces of nature and how they worked. His



thoughts became the seed that was inspired by his sight of that falling apple. This inspiration propelled him to go further to discover the law of gravity.

Isaac Newton went on to propound many more scientific theories that contributed immensely to science in general. What he saw informed him and made him one of the greatest scientists of all time.

Prophet Richard Amoaye has emphasized times without number that “all that is seen is not all that there is” and “whatever is seen is made from that which is not seen”. Many people have eyes, but they cannot see, and ears, but they hear not. In Matthew 6:23, it is written, “but if your eye is bad, your whole body will be full of darkness. If therefore the light that is in you is darkness,

how great is that darkness!”.

According to Ephesians 1:18, “the eyes of your understanding being enlightened; that you may know what the hope of His calling is, what are the riches of the glory of His inheritance”.

Vision is more than what is seen with our eyes; vision is the inspiration that ordinary sight provides in line with the contemplations of the soul. When we meditate on God’s word concerning any matter, the light will shine on such thoughts and birth inspiration, which motivates action. That is what the Psalmist meant when he said Thy word is a lamp unto my feet and a light unto my path (Psalm 119:105). According to Prophet Amoaye, you don’t pursue greatness because greatness is already in you, but when one begins to seek the truth of the word of God, such desire collides with light. The collision will birth vision through sights and symbols, then greatness is manifested.

This is the dynamics of vision and inspiration in line



with manifestations of greatness.

It sounds exaggerated, fictitious or like something you'd read in a fantasy novel. This is because the way God chose to go about it was just dumbfounding and jaw-dropping. He moved mountains and crossed the oceans to bring us together as a unit. For that, we

It all began in 2016, specifically, in the week of the 8th of May. At the time, Isaac was still relatively new in Australia, and he was looking for a home church. He had printed off a list of churches in his local area of Coogee to check out the following weekend, but God, in His infinite wisdom and with a bigger picture, had plans for him about

45 Kilometers away. He encountered a stranger that same week on a Friday night while buying groceries. This stranger happened to be a member of God's Power Ministries - brother Deng. The two exchanged pleasantries at the door, and Isaac went shopping. Deng hadn't left, and he was waiting for Isaac by the door.

Looking back now, I know brother Deng was

inspired by the holy spirit, maybe even unknown to him. The first question he asked Isaac was, "My brother, are you looking for a church? Do you want to come with me to my church?" It's almost as if he knew the need of Isaac the following week. Isaac agreed to attend the church of this stranger. They exchanged numbers and planned to participate in church the next week, on Sunday the 15th of May.

Now, on the other side of town, a young man had proposed marriage, and I was praying to God about

it. The holy spirit kept telling me he was not the one and that a different person prepared for me. I thought, don't even bother asking Papa because the answer is no, and I didn't want to go and waste his time. So, with a lot of murmuring, back chatting, and attitude, I called the young man and explained to him that it was a no regarding the question he had asked, and I didn't want to waste my time or his.

That night I went to bed quite annoyed and frustrated. I took it to the Lord in prayer, but it was more of a conversation where I just vented and poured out my heart. There had been men coming and proposing marriage. It's not like I was out searching; I would be just 'sitting somewhere, minding my own business, and these men were approaching me. Yet each time I went to God in prayer, the answer was no. I vented to God about Him continuing to say no, while the one he said he had prepared – we were not seeing him. In my frustration, I said to God, "If this is how it's going to be, instead of me continuing to say no, I'd even prefer if you just stopped these men from approaching. I'd rather sit and wait for the one you say you've prepared, and when you're ready to bring him, you bring him, and I say yes, and that's it". So, I went to bed quite upset.

The following day was Sunday, 15th of May.



Still, in my attitude, I went to church, and the first person I saw was First Lady. The first thing she told me was that she had randomly dreamt about my future husband sitting opposite her and my uncle at dinner and me. I laughed because I was just shocked at how it was almost as though she was responding to a prayer that I had secretly prayed and a conversation I had with God when I was alone in my room. I took it as a sign that God told me He knows what He is doing, and I need to be patient for the man he had prepared. For me, waiting was not an issue. My problem and worry were that I had a higher chance of choosing the wrong person with all the men coming my way and proposing marriage.

I look back now, and I laugh because I know that no way would've happened with a prophet in my life. There was no way he would've watched

me go down the wrong path, but at the time, I didn't think of that. After the conversation with First Lady, I was surprised, and I went about the church's activities. I later found out they didn't tell me for many months that Sunday also happened to be the day that Isaac came to church for the first time. It was also the day that First Lady went to Prophet Richard (Papa) and pointed out to Isaac, saying, "that is the guy I saw in my dream this morning. How is it possible that the guy I saw this morning is here in the flesh?" She, too, was surprised, and they kept this to themselves

and never told me anything. So, I said no to the young man on the 14th and the 15th; as agreed, Isaac and Deng came to church

A few weeks or about a month went by, and on one day, Pastor Saah approached me and asked what I thought about Isaac. I was annoyed because one of my biggest pet peeves is matchmaking. I wouldn't say I like it, especially when you get to a certain age and people do it. I've always interpreted it as people saying you need help. I knew this was not Pastor Saah's intention, to matchmake. Instead of answering him, I beat about the bush. He then said he thought Isaac was a good guy. I thought to myself, "please, I'm not even looking there". By then, somebody else had now crossed my path, and Isaac, too, was seeing somebody.

Power conference came around, and I encountered prophet Kenneth once upstairs. He said to me, "Amanda, your husband is here. He's around you right now. He's not anywhere else, and when I say he's around you, I mean, he's in the church right now". He left it there, and Prophet Victor Kusi Boateng also came and prophesied that I was in the season for my marriage. He said that every veil would be lifted and that I would be divinely connected to the man I was destined to be with. One of my uncles also prophesied that it was my time for marriage and that my soul and that of my future husband had encountered one another, that in the spirit,



we had been connected, and it was now only a matter of our bodies catching up.

It seemed that everyone around us that had an eye was seeing something that the two of us were not seeing. Not long after that, I approached Papa one day and told him that Isaac had asked me out on a first date. I asked what his thoughts were and what I should do. He paused and smiled. Then he said there was nothing wrong with Isaac and that I should go on a date and get to know him, which was very surprising to me because previously, when a man had asked me or said something, the usual response from Papa would be "my friend, go and find something to do", or, "don't you have something to do?". I always took this as a sign that it meant this was not God's person for me, and I had to concentrate on other things.

This never phased me, although when you are in your late twenties or early thirties, sometimes 16community people make side comments. It was never an issue for me as I was more concerned about marrying the right person.

That day, I left Papa's office and knew in my spirit that there was something different about Isaac because, in all this time, Papa had never said this to me before. We went on a date, and God, in His infinite wisdom, did His thing and brought us together. One of the prayers I had always prayed to God was to let no other person have a hand or be involved in my marriage or meet my future husband as I wanted it to be just God's hand alone so that no man can ever take any glory. Not even me or my future husband. God did grant me this particular wish. Even though God brought us together, it was not given to us on a silver platter. Both of us still had people crossing our paths, almost as if it was like a distraction from each other. However, by God's grace, He pulled us through. We got engaged, and we got married!

The first time I came across the idea of vision boards, I was skeptical. However, after finding several clips, I was won over and convinced that having a physical vision board was a worthwhile investment. For the benefit of anyone who has never seen one, it is essentially a visual representation of the goals and dreams you wish to achieve. These goals and dreams could be short term, long term, or a mix of both. The board essentially enables you to put the key things you wish to accomplish over

time into pictures and, creatively, words or phrases. The most essential and critical part of this is the board should always be placed where you regularly see it.

I was amazed at how what is written in Habakkuk 2 verses 2-3 has been adopted and adapted by many people, most of whom are not Christians or religious. This passage of the Bible says, "Write down this vision and inscribe it on tablets, so that a

herald may run with it. The vision awaits an appointed time; it testifies to the end and does not lie. Though it lingers, wait for it, since it will surely come and will not delay”.

There is greater context to this passage; however, what was astounding for me were the results many people had shared online about how writing down their goals and creating a vision board had helped them remain focused, achieve great things and still be accountable to self, family, and other key people in their lives.

While the motivations of most You-tubers I came across had nothing to do with God, I also came across Christians who explained this from a biblical perspective. I was inspired to follow suit with scriptural understanding and guidance from the Holy Spirit. It dawned on me that I would write my goals and dreams down in a journal or notebook where I got many things wrong. As with most people, I would never revisit this list and sometimes forget I had some plans written down – or the journal would go missing.

For my first ever vision board, I kept it simple. I had reasoned that I would eventually expand the board if it worked out. I set goals for the year related to my spiritual walk with God, physical health, career, and private life. It took some weeks before I made it to the shops, and it was a couple more months before I actually put the board together. By some months, I mean I only got around to implementing this idea a year later—procrastination, of course (nip that in the bud!). I purchased a pinboard (larger than A4 but smaller than A3), sticky notes and drawing pins. I then printed some inspirational statements and wrote out the buzz words that were cues for what I had to achieve for the year. I also revisited prophetic words I had received over the years and used this in my vision board.

Upon completion, I placed it in a spot that was always in my line of sight, i.e. I made sure the board was one of the first things I glanced at when I woke up, the last thing I glanced at when I walked out of the

room and the final thing, I saw at lights out. I was pleasantly surprised at how I became more accountable and improved in certain respects, including becoming a better planner and focusing my prayers more. As a result, I've since expanded on the original board, and at the start of each year, I refresh my vision boards – plural as I now have one for the year and one for the long term.

For me, the vision board doubled up as a self-reflection, prayer, prioritisation, and time management tool. I've been able to preempt specific changes and become better at understanding the kind of opportunities I should either pursue or be on the lookout for. Knowing what I am after means that I'm a bit more ruthless about what I spend time on, who I spend time on and what I can be flexible about. Always remember, not achieving specific goals may be the reason why one other person is unable to live their life to its full potential. Don't take for granted the impact your life can have on another!

Finally, I have learned a couple of things along the way that I think is worth sharing.

1. The effectiveness of a vision board is mainly dependent on your commitment and willingness to invest time and resources into the endeavors on your list.
2. Vision boards and fear don't go hand in hand. Whether you are religious or not, it will not work out if you map the board in fear! When I put mine together, I had at the fore of my mind "Faith of a mustard seed."
3. Ultimately, the board is a tool; you still need to put in the work. You will still need to make tough calls relating to your habits, thinking and lifestyle.

Then, could you do something about it? The truth is, we are our own most significant stumbling blocks, particularly when it comes to mindset and habits!

4. Have sounding boards

Regularly seeing your plans on paper helps you articulate your dreams/ goals to those who matter professionally and personally. If you've got the good-hearted folks around you, they will keep you accountable and help you realize these goals. Don't get trapped into thinking everyone needs to know everything. We all have different strengths, and on occasion, there are some goals you can only share with a select and trusted few. It could be that other people will keep you accountable for other things!

5. Make the most of it!

The vision board is also a great way to identify areas you need to work on and develop your knowledge and skill-sets. Knowing what you desire to achieve and understanding where you may lack knowledge or skill helps you identify the kind of connections you need to be more conscious of. In a non-nar-

...in a systematic way, this can help you be more intentional in who you connect with, i.e.,

you become more aware of the kind of skill-sets, primary mindsets, lifestyles you would benefit from learning from.

To wrap up, I'll say this to you. Some goals and visions don't come to pass because we do not plan well or put structures to help us achieve the goals. When you meet people as the year progresses, you become more intentional in your time distribution, both in your professional and private life, if you know your priorities. If you genuinely get enamored by what is possible, especially with God, you need to define and draw your boundaries. Some people will get it, some won't, and that's OK!

Like Prophet Richard Amoaye once said, and I paraphrase, you still need to do your part in the natural! So, if you're looking for a way to be more effective or productive, perhaps this may be one helpful tool. However, remember that a vision board is simply a tool. It is a constant reminder of your why, and you're how.
