



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
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# Pst. Hero Udenyi

# IN THE LIGHT OF THE PROPHETIC By Pastor Hero Udenyi

"You do not need to be a **prophet** to be prophetic, and being able to **prophesy** does not make you a prophet" - **Prophet Richard Amoaye**.

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"On no point have good people so entirely disagreed as on prophecies and the interpretation of prophecy; on no point have the prejudices of one group, the dogmatism of a second and the extravagance of a third done so much to rob the church of truths which God intended to be a blessing".

- J. C. Ryle

The Prophetic ministry is the most misunderstood today, even amongst Christians generally and the Pentecostal churches particularly. Many Christians are still sceptical of the prophetic, while others

who believe in it have no proper understanding. For these reasons, the prophetic has become the most abused and misunderstood aspect in Christianity today.

Some believe the prophetic is a thing of the past as it was only suitable in the Old Testament. Many others who though believe, think that the prophetic is merely the reliance on the gift of prophecy and revelations from God to the people. On the other hand, some believe that the prophetic is a part of the five-fold ministries and is only one of many gifts of the Holy Spirit. While all these are factual, it is still not the whole truth.

In the Old Testament, God raised for Himself prophets to speak his word to encourage, rebuke and counsel. In 2 Samuel, Prophet Nathan was often sent by God to King David to rebuke, counsel and confront when necessary. There are many other prophets in the Old Testament whom God used at different times for different reasons, but mainly to teach, give guidance, counsel, or rebuke as necessary.

### The doctrine of necessity

As important as the preceding may be, there are still so many contemporary Christians who have argued that prophecy and the prophetic were only necessary while the Bible was yet to be completed and therefore ended as

soon as the New Testament was written. They believe that the reason for all the signs and gifts by the Holy Spirit in the early church was to validate the apostles' ministry and give direction until the New Testament was completed. Once the Bible was completed and the apostles died, all the miraculous gifts of the Holy Spirit ceased being of use in the church. This school of thought argues that the completed Bible is enough to guide us in our journey with Christ and that no

additional words or signs from the Lord are necessary.

There are yet others who argue that the prophetic practice of foretelling is not part of the teachings of the New Testament. This school of thought believes that the prophetic should only be expressed as forth-telling the written word of God and not foretelling. According to them, like the previous group, there is no more fresh word from God, so prophecy can only be in the preaching of that which is written and not in predicting. In their view, every teacher and preacher of the written word of God is a prophet. They do not believe in the prophetic ministry and those who present themselves as vessels for the flow of the fresh light and revelation from heaven. They do not believe that God could still speak to us in dreams, nor do they believe anyone could have an accurate interpretation of dreams by the Holy Spirit. Some people even think that to predict the future and speak in new tongues by the Holy Spirit is no longer necessary today.

### More questions than answers

What shall we say then? The Bible is complete, so there cannot be any addition to the written word of God in the Bible, nor can there be a subtraction from that which is written. It is also true that the written word of God could be preached and thought prophetically. The question then is, how do we interpret, teach, and apply the Bible to practically guide us in our Christian journey on earth? What do we

say about the overt manifestations of these gifts in the Church today? If the gifts of the Holy Spirit have ceased since the New Testament was completed, what then is the place of the Holy Spirit in the Church today? Why is it only the signs and gifts of the Holy Spirit that had ceased when all the gifts were given together for the edification and the perfecting of the saint (Ephesians 4:11-12)? Is it not rather curious that the signs and gifts of the Holy Spirit, which are: prophecy, miracles, healings, and tongues that were given together by the same spirit for the same purpose, 'the building of the church and the authentications of the ministers of God' would be the only gifts to cease? Something is just not right somewhere.

### The necessity of the prophetic

The Bible bears witness to itself when it says, "All Scripture is inspired by God and profitable for teaching, for reproof, for correction, for training in righteousness; that the man of God may be adequate, equipped for every good work" (2 Timothy 3:16-17). For I testify unto every man that heareth the words of the prophecy of this book If any man shall add unto these things, God shall add unto him the plagues that are written in this book: And if any man shall "When the Spirit is poured out, the first thing that shows that the spirit has been poured out is that people will prophesy... the gift of prophecy was never meant to end at the end time but rather to escalate at the end time "until the day of the Lord has come".

take away from the words of the book of this prophecy, God shall take away his part out of the book of life, and out of the holy city, and from the things which are written in this book (Revelation 22:18-19).

While I am yet to read a piece in the Bible that says that the prophetic ministry is no longer relevant to Christianity today, the above scripture seems to say whatever is in the Bible, including the prophetic gifts, was inspired by God and completed by itself. None must add nor subtract from that which is recorded already. That same Bible recorded thus, "And afterwards, I will pour out My Spirit on all people. Your sons and daughters will prophesy, your old men will dream dreams, your young men will see visions" (Joel 2:28). This scripture was again quoted in (Acts 2:16-20) "But this is that which was spoken by the prophet Joel; And it shall come to pass in the last days, saith God, I will pour out of my Spirit upon all flesh: and your sons and your daughters shall prophesy, and your young men shall see visions, and your old men shall dream dreams: And on my servants and my handmaidens I will pour out in those days of my Spirit; and they shall prophesy: And I will shew wonders in heaven above, and signs in the earth beneath; blood, and fire, and vapour of smoke: The sun shall be turned into darkness, and the moon into blood, before that great and notable day of the Lord come".

Notice the strategic place of the gift of prophecy in the end-time move of God. When the Spirit is poured out, the first thing that shows that the spirit has been poured out is that people will prophesy. From Peter's explanation, this prophecy in Joel was meant for the end-time move of God, which began with the disciples in the upper room in Acts of the Apostles chapter two. This shows that the gift of prophecy was never meant to end at the end time but rather to escalate at the end time until "the day of the Lord has come".



God is a consistent God in His dealings with man. After Moses complained of the weight of the work of ministry upon him, the Lord asked him to gather the elders so He would put upon them His Spirit. (Numbers 11:25) "And the Lord came down in a cloud, and spoke unto him, and took of the spirit that was upon him, and gave it unto the seventy elders: and it came to pass, that, when the spirit rested upon them, they prophesied, and did not cease. The same thing happened in Acts of the Apostles chapter two. God poured out His spirit, and all the people prophesied.

The gift of prophecy is specifically mentioned amongst

the many other gifts of the Holy Spirit in 1 Corinthians 12:10 "To another the working of miracles; to another prophecy; to another discerning of spirits; to another divers kinds of tongues; to another the interpretation of tongues". Also, in Ephesians 4:11-12, "And he gave some, apostles; and some, prophets; and some,



evangelists; and some, pastors and teachers; For the perfecting of the saints, for the work of the ministry, for the edifying of the body of Christ". In Numbers 11:29, it reads, "And Moses said unto him, Envies thou for my sake? would God that all the Lord's people were prophets, and that the Lord would put his spirit upon them!". Finally in 1 Corinthians 14:5, it reads," I wish that all of you could speak in tongues, but I would rather have you prophesy". It is clear that all the gifts of the Holy Spirit, including the gift of prophecy, were all for the perfecting of the church. And so, as long as the church is not yet perfected, the gifts would still be needed.

### Conclusion

The full prophetic ministry includes the forth-telling of God's written Word and fore-telling through a miracle of knowledge, a declaration or description or representation of something future, beyond the power of human sagacity to foresee, discern, or conjecture. However, in forth-telling or foretelling, the word received and delivered must be consistent with the written word of God. The prophetic is not merely relying on the gift of prophecy and revelations from God to the people. It's not just a part of the five-fold ministries nor just one of many gifts of the Holy Spirit. The prophetic ministry, when properly understood, is the comprehensive administration of the mind of God to give the saints an advantage over the system of the world through foretelling, interpretation of dreams and visions, teaching, guidance, counselling, or rebuking when and as necessary by the Holy Spirit.



Finally, the prophetic or the gift of prophecy is not a thing of the past, as we have seen through the eyes of  $\frac{1}{2}$ many scriptures. It's as important in this dispensation as it was in the Old and without it, the church will not be able to administer full advantage of the grace of our Lord Jesus Christ in the work of ministry.

### THE PROPHETIC VOICE



I would like to take this opportunity thank Prophet to Richard Owusu Amoaye for speaking prophetically upon my life. Unfortunately, I did not take heed and remain under the covering shelter of God. Fortunately, I quickly recovered and also mainly because when the prophesy was revealed a corporate prayer was petitioned for me by the whole church. On June 26 2018, the doctors went through with the surgery successfully. After the surgery I attended the conference and God located me yet again and another corporate prayer was made for me but this time it was even more powerful as we had 2 anointed prophets of God standing in the gap. After the conference, I was tested for cancer and all tests were negative and I am now cancer free. When the prophecy of death was revealed, the Prophets of God stood in the gap for me through prayer. When the congregation lifted their hands in one accord and a decree was declared on my behalf the angels immediately surrounded me and I was covered by the blood of Jesus.

Pandemics, epidemics and catastrophes have come and gone. The human race will always face some form of predicament. During biblical times, there have been many instances of pandemics which shook the world.

It is that time of the year New!!! again when we look forward to the tax returns period and the end of the financial year. The end of the financial year (EOFY) is an important time for many businesses as they complete their bookkeeping, their tax returns and plan for the new financial year ahead. During this period, the EOFY sales are usually launched as retailers offer bargains before the closing of business books on June 30th. Discounts are available on everything from big-ticket items such as cars, phones, and appliances, to tech gadgets, clothing and even telco, internet, and energy plans! The main reason brands run EOFY sales, also known as tax-time deals, is to sell last season's stock and make way for shiny new stuff before the new financial year. The Old stock holidays, days of the week, must Go and make way for the months, years, and seasons.

During this time, most of us run around and chase a good bargain on an item that was relatively unaffordable but now is unavoidable. We dig deep into our pockets to meet these somewhat ridiculous deals and would go so far as to put it on credit and do anything to snatch a good bargain.

On the other hand, any stock the retailer keep in their inventory loses value over time. The longer it sits there, the more it costs them to have it. It is almost like a squatter who won't pay rent. They have until EOFY to cough it up, or they get the boot!!!

In the bible, Israelites would emphasise specific They would follow these 'religiously'. An example is the Year of Jubilee, which comes every 50th year. Jubilee was a year of releasing people from their debts, releasing slaves from their masters, and returning properties to their owners. It was also a year dedicated to resting from work. During this year, the Israelites were not supposed to reap or harvest; it was a time for people to return to their families and loved ones (Christianity.com). With the way our world is today, we would certainly welcome such a year.

Another for reason Jubilee was to acknowledge that God is the provider of all. From a practical standpoint, it gave the land a chance to rest from sowing and reaping. We learn that part of the reason why the Israelites went into captivity was that they did not observe these resting years (Leviticus 26). They didn't trust that God would provide for them and hence did not dedicate any time to rest.

Jubilee also was a representation of future work by God through Christ. Christ would come down and live among us, doing the 'work' of God. He would then go on the cross to relieve us of all spiritual debts and our slavery to sin. This shows us that God takes rest very seriously. Part of the reason is that He does not want us to idolise work. He doesn't want us to live a life without Him. If we can do all things by the sweat of our brow,

why would we need God? In the same way, God wants us to dedicate some time to step away from our laptops so we can read His word and worship Him.

Going back to the EOFY, we see businesses letting old stock go at cost and sometimes with a loss to the business. Sometimes we need to do all it takes to get rid of that old baggage, so there is room for new blessings.

"So, Elijah went from there and found Elisha's son of Shaphat. He was ploughing with twelve yokes of

oxen, and he himself was driving the twelfth pair. Elijah went up to him and threw his cloak around him. Elisha then left his oxen and ran after Elijah. "Let me kiss my father and mother goodbye," he said, "and then I will come with you." "Go back," Elijah replied. "What have I done to you?" So, Elisha left him and went back. He took his yoke of oxen and slaughtered them. He burned the ploughing equipment to cook the meat and gave it to the people, and they ate. Then he set out to follow Elijah and became his servant." - 1 Kings 19:19-21

In the text, Elijah was advised by God to anoint Elisha as his successor. He finds Elisha and puts his cloak around him. Elisha understood the meaning of this, and he chose to get rid of all that he owned, so there would be room for who he was going to be. A rebranding of sorts. He slaughtered his oxen, cooked the meat with wood from his equipment and gave that meat away for others to eat. He gave it all away with no gain, and it seems a bit dramatic that he did so. Some may ask why So how do we partake of this so-called greatness. In such times as we live in today, this may be essential to our survival. Superiority over Covid-19 perhaps or the circumstances of its existence... How does one then step into greatness when all we see is chaos?





he didn't just leave it with his mother and father. Why didn't he just give away the equipment and oxen to the people? What was the motive behind burning the wood and cooking the meat with it?

When our lives become a cycle or loop, we know it is time for a change. We were created to keep advancing and moving forward. When we wake up each day and do the same thing repeatedly, we soon feel that something is lacking in our lives. We feel unfulfilled, and part of the reason is that God created us to be creators on earth. Elisha's oxen were a part of him. They were a part of his life and routine. They were linked to his success and identity. They were a means to a harvest. A harvest that would provide him access to much more than just food and water. He had tied his identity to his possessions, and that wasn't God's plan for his life. He quickly got rid of his old identity to make way for the new. To rebrand through relinquishing his past. The old stock had to Go!!!

Part of the reason we do not see the change  $\frac{1}{5}$  we wish to experience in our lives is that we are unwilling to let go of what we have known all our

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lives. Our past truth is the most reliable truth. We are not open to new ideas and revelations because we are comfortable with what we already know. New is scary. New is untested. New is uncool. New is unreliable. We choose to wait when something new comes out because it's better for it to fail in someone else's hands but not ours. An example was the Samsung Galaxy Note 9. It had battery issues which led to the smartphone exploding while charging. Samsung had to recall all sold devices, and those who hadn't bought one were glad they had waited.

The kingdom of God relies on us holding on to God and His promises pertaining to our lives. It relies on us being open-minded and seeing beyond what is physical. It relies on us opening our hearts to His Word and allowing Jesus to be our Shepherd (Psalms 23). We usually use the phrase 'Rock Bottom' to imply a point where we have lost everything or exhausted all physical possibilities of a resolution. We also use the phrase 'stuck between a rock and a hard place'. The bible calls Jesus to be our Rock. In relation to these phrases, does that not imply we have gone so low to the point where Jesus has caught up with us? He will not let us free fall into oblivion! Does that not imply that Jesus is the point we should begin to rebuild our lives upon? Are we willing to alter where our lives are headed through trusting in God, allowing Jesus to be our anchor and opening ourselves up to the Supernatural and the Prophetic? Is Jesus not the

only option? Will we change the trajectory of our lives by the renewal of our minds - Romans 12?

Seven takeaway messages in this article are this:

- Be willing to let go of the old, which will not get you where you need to be. - Isaiah 43:18-19





In the very first paragraph to the introduction it reads, "A common misconception that has arisen among many within the body of Christ in this end time is the belief that excellence comes by default once one becomes a child of God". From here, the author goes on to establish that the grace, I daresay many of us sing continuously about and confess, that contains an element of godly responsibility, and it is this responsibility that provides a foundation for godly excellence. In chapter 1, the author walks you through the significance of Shechem and from chapter 2 onwards, he reintroduces you to Joseph's journey. As a #teamJoseph fan, I'm glad to share that the book delivers beyond expectation when it comes to a detailed examination of his character and ethics. Not only that but there are some unique angles I had never thought of until reading Decoding. For example, why is it that Joseph is described as the son of Jacob's old age when Benjamin was the last born. Or better yet, I had never noticed the connection between Shechem, godly responsibility and excellence (actually, I may never have known this without reading the book!).

Decoding offers thought provoking comparative examinations of Joseph and other giants of the faith. Not only that, but the book also asks some probing questions about personalities we have often read about. For example, have you ever wondered why Isaac was blind in his old age when this was not part of the promise and blessing from God?
