MANIFESTING GREATNESS THE SUPERNATURAL

"Whether we are aware or not, we are enveloped by the supernatural all around us"- **Richard Amoaye.**

"The supernatural means power or effect or agent or gift or end that is not natural and that is outside the order of nature on account of direct divine intervention" – **Thomas Aquinas**.

The supernatural concept has fascinated humans with many ideas and concepts proposed of its operation over the centuries. The supernatural is the origin of the natural. It is not just a coincidence that occasionally happens. The supernatural has been investigated, studied, and repeatedly used to describe something beyond comprehension. Does the supernatural play any part in nature, is it just a natural occurrence, or is it an intentional phenomenon by an entity designed to interfere and or intervene in the natural course of things?

In this article, we want to look at the workings of the supernatural in inspiring and manifesting greatness. We shall once again take


inspiration from the messages of our father in the Lord, Prophet Richard Amoaye, who has incidentally declared this year as the year of the supernatural.

The word supernatural is compounded from super and natural to explain something above the natural. In the real sense, the word supernatural cannot be given a clear definition that is acceptable across the board. The origin is not based on science, but it is popularly used to describe things that cannot be explained. The term is vague, ambiguous and has never been passed through scientific verification or epistemic justification. However, its popularity has given rise to many definitions based on context.

philosophy, the word supernatural encompasses phenomena that aren't subject to the laws of nature. The supernatural requires a violation of physical law believed to have been attributed to interdimensional/extradimensional beings, such as God, angels, demons.

The supernatural order is the original and fundamental source of all things. This order defines the limits of what may be known. Something supernatural is above and beyond the natural world.

We could go on and on trying to look at different definitions of the word supernatural, and we might not find an end because there is really no end to it. The supernatural has to do with God Himself, who cannot be absolutely understood or explained by an ordinary mind. The supernatural is the domain of God, far beyond any and every human comprehension.

To paint the picture, Prophet Amoaye referred to Genesis 1:1, which reads, "in the beginning, God created the heavens and the earth". While some people may have a problem with a creator figure, that fact speaks for itself that there is heaven and earth.

He explained that the heavens rule over the earth because the seen was created from the unseen just as light comes out of the darkness. Prophet Amoaye said that "there is more to see than what you see and there more to know than what you know". The heavens seem to be the host of what is known as the supernatural. In contrast, the earth is the field of its manifestation.

Prophet Richard Amoaye argues that man was created in the image and likeness of

God and was initially meant to derive power from God to become as great as God has made him be. However, man disconnected from the power source and attempted to source his power elsewhere (Genesis 3:1-8). The prophet also posited that man is a spirit with a soul and dwells in the body; therefore, the fundamental nature of man is spiritual, and those who understand this and can utilise such understanding have consistently produced excellent results.

Prophet Amoaye, in his teachings, said that everything below is influenced by the things above. In other words, heaven rules the earth, as Daniel stated to King Nebuchadnezzar (Daniel 4:26). What we usually call the supernatural are the intentional works of God to intervene in the world of humans. But to God, it is not supernatural but an

everyday natural deliberate occurrence which he desires to share with man.

To infer from the teachings of the prophet, the supernatural can be accessed and deployed for the benefit of humankind. Humans, as spirit beings, are supposed to live from the spiritual perspective but have instead turned to the physical perspective, which in the true sense, is only a product of the spiritual or the supernatural. The supernatural is a realm where men of renown have transacted and gotten results in times past and even now.

In the teaching, the view presented/expressed was that, humans have become so carnally minded to the detriment of their real nature, which is spiritual, so much so that they have submitted

their destiny to the rulership of nature. If human beings were created to rule nature, they must have superior intelligence and not be subject to nature (Genesis 1:27-28). He lamented that humans will never reach their full potential if we rely only on what is seen; because there is more than what meets the eyes. However, man has turned from the source to the sourced. Daniel said, "they that know their God shall be powerful and they shall do great things" (Daniel 11:32). Greatness is in reconnecting to the original power source. With all that said, how do we deploy the supernatural for more significant results on the earth?



DEPLOYING THE SUPERNATURAL

Access is primary to the deployment of the supernatural. Access could be through an entrance, a door, a window. Prophet Amoaye noted that while there are so many access routes, not all access is the right access. He gave an example of mathematics where you might solve a mathematical problem. If the process of arriving at that solution is not by the right formula, then the answer would not be awarded the desired mark. Therefore, the way you gain access is very important and relevant to the implications

of your result.

Under the preceding argument, access must be through the door for the right result to manifest. Prophet Amoaye pointed to the indisputable claims of Jesus Christ when he said, "I am the door" (John 10: 9). While we may concede that there are other routes, we submit here that Jesus Christ of Nazareth is the only one who has made this very bold statement of fact, "I am the door". Interestingly he did not say that he is "a" door; He said He is "the" Door. This statement stands undisputed, so we can confidently say that we have found the access, the door, Jesus Christ.

The prophet laid out a progression into the supernatural by referring

The prophet laid out a progression into the supernatural by referring to the story of Nicodemus and Jesus Christ recorded in (John 3:1-15). In this story, Nicodemus, a professor of law, linguistics and philosophy, a member of the Sanhedrin, and most probably a high-ranking initiate into the sacred Judaic cult of enlightenment, came to Jesus by night asking Jesus what he must do to access the supernatural. We must see the progression here. Nicodemus was already standing at the door, but he had no access, so he asked. He recognised that Jesus was operating from the supernatural realm (John 3:2), and he wondered how access could be granted to him.

Jesus gave him the formula in (John 3:3), "Truly, truly, I say to you, unless one is born again, he cannot see the kingdom of God." There are three essential words here: Born again, See, and Enter. Therein is the formula of progression for access to the supernatural. According to the formula, to gain access into the supernatural, one must:

- **1. Be born again.** (John 3:16) When you are born again, you are born of the Holy Spirit of God, so you become a spirit, as it were. This allows one to grow in the things of the spirit, i.e., the supernatural. Spiritual growth is indicated by how much one has died to the works of the flesh, which impact the result the life of the spirit is producing (Galatian 5:16).
- **2. See.** There is a depth of inspiration that needs the eyes of the spirit to access. Once a man is born again, the spirit opens their eyes of understanding to begin to see the things of the spirit, which is the realm of the supernatural (Ephesians 1:18). However, see here connotes 'to locate".
- **3. Enter.** Once the realm is located, then it can be accessed. This means that perception is followed by a reception and once you have received you can then demonstrate just like Jesus did. But notice that the word enter here means steps must be taken to access.

Actions based on faith must be followed to

manifest what is perceived and then there will be evidence (Luke 1:45). Word belief or faith is the password in the realm of the supernatural. (Romans 10:10-17).

In conclusion, Prophet Richard Amoaye said, "humanity's dependence on only the intellectual has limited man in time and space. Man is interdimensional in his liberated form.

According to Etta D. Jackson in Man, Who Art Thou; government and big private institutions are spending billions into establishing "think tanks" for the intellectual elites of our time to find the answers to the world's problems. However, wars, poverty, and humanity's demise are still on the increase at alarming rates.

Ordinary people such as Debora, Esther, Joseph, and Daniel in the Bible days and John Wesley, Isaac Newton, Archbishop Benson Idahosa of blessed memories were all men of great results through the supernatural. Presently, we could talk about mighty men of valour such as Oral Roberts, Archbishop Nicholas Duncan-Williams, and Prophet Victor Kusi Boateng, though ordinary men but by one revelation from the supernatural delivered and are still delivering mind-blowing revolutionary results in their world. We do not need to blow our own trumpet but permit me to mention a closer example; Prophet Richard Amoaye who through one revelation raising champions through the power of God for Kingdom advancement has raised men and women from the doldrums of life to the pinnacles of hope. These are a few examples that man can receive inspiration from the

supernatural for more excellent results upon the face of the earth.

The supernatural is God's domain'. 'natural and man through Jesus Christ has been reconciled and restored to that same domain of the supernatural. From whence he can access ancient knowledge far superior to the best of human intellectualism. The supernatural beckons on humanity eager to show forth and manifest the greatness and glory of God upon the face of the earth (2 Corinthians 5:17 - 20).







few days later while in hospital with my grandmother, she kept insisting I was pregnant, and I kept telling her I wasn't pregnant, and indeed I wasn't. 
read my thoughts, he said, "You're only a child and don't worry. By the time I come for the power conference, you will have physical evidence of the congratulations".

However, a massive part of me was still stuck on losing both my grandparents in one year and that I was entering a new year and a new decade without them. That night I cried, and I asked God a few questions. After a visit to a GP, I was told that I was indeed pregnant fast forward mid-January. I immediately thought of my grandparents and wouldn't be around to witness this


moment. The moment I took a step outside the Gp's office, the holy spirit dropped in my heart the answer to one of my guestions from the 31st night. He said that i gained a husband when i lost my grandfather, and when i lost my grandmother, i gained a child. Yes, you left 2019 without two people you love dearly, but you also left 2019 with two people who weren't in your life before, and you will love dearly in the years to come.

I console my heart and soul with those words that the holy spirit had ministered to me. The pregnancy was a breeze till about the eighth month. I was diagnosed with a lifethreatening condition to our

daughter, and I had a higher chance of delivering a stillborn. As the pregnancy progressed, we were told I would be induced between 35 to 37 weeks if nothing had gone wrong.

I managed to get to that time, but every second day I was going for blood tests and baby scans and checks to make sure she was alive and not in trouble. When the day came for induction, before I could make it to the hospital, I went into labour. This caused the doctors and nurses to assume that the baby was in trouble, and indeed she was, but through it all, God was faithful.

We called Papa, and he prayed

with us. We spoke to mama as well, and she said nothing would happen. We've already seen the baby walking around and being part of our family events, so take heart. The labour process was not easy, but God brought us out on the other side once again.

When we went into the hospital, we were unsure how the delivery would be like and whether I was delivering a stillborn or not. But we came out on the other side with a baby alive and well. God has been truly faithful to our family, and he alone deserves the glory.

I've realized that doing things God's way and obeying God's voice makes all the difference, and marrying or choosing early does not account for much but marrying right and purposefully. It makes up for everything, and it makes all the difference. It is our prayer that as God has done for us, by moving mountains and crossing oceans, to bring us together as husband and wife, everybody that reads this and is believing God for the destined spouse, their story will be greater than ours. We hope that everybody will hear of it and honestly say, yes, this must be the hand of God and that anybody that's looking for the fruit of the womb a year by this time, it will be your story that we are reading in the Prophetic Voice Magazine in Jesus' name.

I desired to be famous from childhood, and I always dreamt about being part of the "greats". When I began going to school and learning about how the world worked, this desire grew, and I had my eyes set on becoming great. However, my understanding and definition of greatness were conflated with fame and informed by what I saw in movies, films, and music videos (90s Rap, RnB, and Hip Hop)!

When I was in my teens, on my list of goals to achieve were some daring feats, and for a while, I was pretty determined to make it. CEO of a top performing fortune 500 by age 25. Never mind that I had no clue what that entirely meant or entailed. Also, on my goals list were two or three fully paid properties,

including a holiday condo in some exotic location (the Bahamas or the Caribbean). My two cars plus luxury sports vehicles for good measure, private jet for convenient travels for what would have been my growing empire and of course weekend getaway sightseeing and finally a yacht ('just because').

If the heavens allowed me additional 'bonus points on the success ladder', I also had Nobel Laureate for some unknown-yet- to be defined



category that would make more sense in the future. By age 35 would have been great because retirement in my plans was something I hoped to achieve by age 40. Some worthwhile philanthropic ventures were also on my goals list for good PR and street credibility. I wanted to be a trailblazer, a force to be reckoned with and my name synonymous with excellence and riches (great emphasis on RICHES!!). That was the vision.

I had several goals, and I had plans. I was on a mission until the 'terrible triplets', namely reality, growth and maturity, began to tap me on the shoulder regularly. These triplets, combined with a flailing economy in my motherland, meant many things had to change and, unfortunately, shift. With time, there were many revisions to the central vision, and many goals had to

be adjusted.

Before I hit the age of 18, there was a lot more I had to reconsider till eventually the hope by age 19 had become getting a good job and simply paying bills when I got into adulthood. A lot more seemed unrealistic, out of reach, and, more importantly – prideful and self-centred—the latter, realisations resulting from my encounters with Christ as a young adult in a foreign land.

What had fuelled my passion and desire to be great was initially what had been portrayed in the media

and news. While checking in with God about why I was created and what I was meant to do in life was something that did cross my mind; I was never patient or still enough to read the bible, pray God centred prayers genuinely, and most importantly, I did not understand what it meant to wait on and hear God. Even though I was a practising Christian, my idea of what it meant to be great and significant equated to having material possessions and advantages in many dimensions of my life; it was not just a desire for possessions and benefits; it was a strong desire for excess, privilege, and power.

It was not until a series of radical encounters with scriptures that I realised being great, according to God, is about faith, love, and hope. It is about faithfulness and obedience to the word. Not only that, but genuinely loving and serving humanity, taking the narrow path, and bringing glory and honour to God and what that looks like is drastically different to what the world portrays. It dawned on me that it was about achieving purpose and accomplishing the mission that God sends you on not in some distant future, but the mission He sends us on every day you live.

Often, we overcomplicate this thing called purpose and living for God. We conflate greatness with fame and convert it into a specific future event when the reality is that greatness is and continues to be forged through the simplicity of our daily activities. It is formed in our service line and becomes the legacy we leave behind. What



God needs is for us to serve where we are, in the now, despite how we feel and what we think. What He needs is for us to have faith in the now, obey His word in the now and let His love move and lead us in the now for the benefit of His kingdom.

One of the best and impressionable examples I heard about greatness was this. The baker who is designed to be a baker and shows up on time to serve the people with compassion and faith is great in the eyes of God. The same applies to a farmer who is

designed as a farmer but chooses to do something different. In the eyes of God, the farmer misses the mark as it is about purpose, functionality, and posture in the present. What drives you, and why do you desire to be great? Where does God fit in the picture, or is it the case

Q: Tell us a bit about yourself and how did you get into Music?

My name is Billie Olela. I was born and raised in the Democratic Republic of Congo where i lived until the age of 12. We then moved and lived in Johannesburg South Africa for nearly 10 years before moving once more. I started singing at a very young age in the local church Sunday school music group. Then later I joined the local church worship team.



Q: Who are your musical inspirations?

My primary musical inspiration is my mother who also was my local church worship leader for a few years. Her passion for worship is the element that inspires me.

Q:How old were you when you wrote your first and what inspired the song?

I wrote my first official song at age 31. The song is called "Thou Art Welcome". The inspiration for the song was the deep thirsting and longing in my heart for an encounter with the Lord at that point in my life.

Q: What challenges did you encounter in the process of writing this?

The challenge I faced with this first song came from the internal wrestling in my heart as the Lord was pushing me to record the song, but I did not feel ready as I felt that the song might not be inspiring to others. The breakthrough came for me when I first sang it to other members of the local church worship team, and I was greatly encouraged to push through and record it with the team.

Q: What is the name of your latest single?


