In a believer's walk, one can do nothing without Jesus. According to the above scripture, one can only flourish when they abide in Him. One's fruitfulness is therefore dependent upon their connectivity to the vine (Jesus). A branch that is not attached to the vine effectively dies. Abiding in Him thus becomes critical to our very survival, so what does it mean?

To abide as used in the above context refers to not just subscription to the teachings of Jesus Christ and of scripture but to an assimilation and application of those teachings. When we abide in Him, we embrace all that He offers without cessation. One cannot abide today and cease tomorrow. For one to abide, there has to

be an attachment, a joining. When detachment from the body occurs, flow is interrupted resulting in bleeding.

YOU ARE WHAT YOU EAT

You are what you eat is a common phrase. It implies that what we take in (consume) plays a role in moulding who we are physically. When we eat healthy, our bodies are well nourished and thus able to execute their function with greater efficiency which is reflected in the quality of life we enjoy. When one ingests a mango for example, the body will extract the nutritional elements it requires from the mango and filter out the waste. Through this

consumption, part of the mango has now become of you; you possess an element of that which you have eaten. One however cannot be sustained on this singular meal perpetually, the process of food consumption would need to be sustained regularly to maintain the needed nutritional and energy demands of the body.

Then Jesus said to them, "Most assuredly, I say to you, unless you eat the flesh of the Son of Man and drink His blood, you have no life in you. Whoever eats My flesh and drinks My blood has eternal life, and I will raise him up at the last day. For My flesh is food indeed, and My blood is drink indeed. He who eats My flesh and drinks My blood abides in Me, and I in him. As the living Father sent Me, and I live because of the Father, so he who feeds on Me will live because of Me. This is the bread which came down

from heaven—not as your fathers ate the manna, and are dead. He who eats this bread will live forever." **John 6:53-58 NKJV**

So He humbled you, allowed you to hunger, and fed you with manna which you did not know nor did your fathers know, that He might make you know that man shall not live by bread alone; but man lives by every word that proceeds from the mouth of the Lord. **Deuteronomy 8:3 NKJV**

There is physical food and there's spiritual food. Physical food alone is not enough to provide man with all he needs for sustenance of his entire being i.e. spirit, soul and body. Physical food sustains you physically and spiritual food will sustain you spiritually. Just as our physical wellness is premised on our eating habits, so too is our spiritual wellness premised on what we take in spiritually.

And the Lord God commanded the man, saying, "Of every tree of the garden you may freely eat; but of the tree of the knowledge of good and evil you shall not eat, for in the day that you eat of it you shall surely die." **Genesis 21: 6-17 NKJV**

Eating is a means through which energy is transferred. In our earlier analogy of the mango tree, when we eat of the mango tree, we take in certain elements of that fruit. The same holds true in the above scripture, when Adam and Eve ate of the tree of knowledge of good and evil they assimilated the energy that tree carried within itself.

The tree of knowledge of good and evil was a peculiar tree, it was one whose fruit fed not just the body but also the soul. Physical food is digested and egested. Food that feeds your soul however has no physical outlet. Consequently, whatever is true of that tree of good and evil becomes

true of the one who eats of it. Ensuing this act of transgression, God in His grace and mercy drives the man out of the garden and away from the tree of life lest his current state becomes permanent. Saints, everything we do sans God is tantamount to eating from the tree of knowledge of good and evil and the result is

Then He said to them all, “If anyone desires to come after Me, let him deny himself, and take up his cross daily, and follow Me. For whoever desires to save his life will lose it, but whoever loses his life for My sake will save it. For what profit is it to a man if he gains the whole world, and is himself destroyed or lost?

Luke 9:23-25 NKJV

The antidote to death through wrong diet i.e. eating of the tree of good and evil is laying down one's life and receiving the life of Christ so that it is His life expressed through us. Oftentimes, our folly lies in trying to effect change through sheer human effort without consulting the creator. It is akin to trying to apprehend the wind with your bare hands. Hence the reason it is paramount that we abide in Him.

But Jesus answered him, saying, “It is written, ‘Man shall not live by bread alone, but by every word of God.’”

LUKE 4: 4 NKJV

Jesus's retort to the devil was essentially that the Word of God is the food from God. Whatever is true of physical food is true of the Word of God. The greatest disservice one can do to themselves is to pursue understanding of the Word while rejecting a relationship with God.

who also made us sufficient as ministers of the new covenant, not of the letter but of the Spirit; for the letter kills, but the Spirit gives life.

2 CORINTHIANS 3: 6 NKJV

The truth of the Word of God is hidden in the letter but it is not the letter. The Bible is a collaboration between man and God. Man provides the letter and God infuses His Spirit within which is grace. Ergo, when one accesses the Word, the Spirit encapsulated in the letter also penetrates into man in places that not even the finest surgeon can access.

In Him was life, and the life was the light of men. And the light shines in the darkness, and the darkness did not comprehend it.

JOHN 1: 4-5 NKJV

The Word of God is the light of God. We access the Word which is food and this converts into life. This life morphs into light which illuminates you. The marvel of this light is that it also contains grace. One therefore not only accesses truth which sets one free but also supernatural endowment to live in this revealed truth. The Holy Spirit *aka* The Spirit of Truth is the Person responsible for churning the received Word to light or Truth. It is only through relationship with the Father through His Son, Jesus Christ, that we have access to The Holy Spirit. The Holy Spirit is thus cardinal to appropriation of the Word.

Jesus said to them, "My food is to do the will of Him who sent Me, and to finish His work.

JOHN 4: 34 NKJV

The will of God is embodied in His Word. One's will is a component of their soul and it is their expectations of a thing. One's will is known when one vocalises their thoughts or expectations. Your words therefore express your will. Jesus in the

above verse was therefore saying that He has access to the mind of God and thus knows the Father's will. Jesus not only knew God's will but He executed the Father's will on earth and this was food to Him as it brought satisfaction or fulfillment.

For God so loved the world that He gave His only begotten Son, that whoever believes in Him should not perish but have everlasting life. **JOHN 3: 16 NKJV**

The only antidote to the process of death that was triggered due to eating of the tree of knowledge of good and evil is the belief in the begotten of the Father. When we believe in the Son of God, we will not perish. When we believe, we have life through the Word of God. Brethren, we must remain in a continuous process of feeding on the Word of God. We must remain connected to the source. A disconnection from the source leads to weariness and vulnerability to the enemy. We become an easy target for a concentrated attack from the enemy who takes



advantage to ensure we do not get up again and restore a relationship with the Father.

*Most assuredly, I say to you, unless a grain of wheat falls into the ground and dies, it remains alone; but if it dies, it produces much grain. **JOHN 12: 24 NKJV***

Engaging with the Word of God is an engagement with divine truth. The Word of God in us dispels darkness. Whatever you feed, grows stronger. As our Spirit man through fellowship with the Word gains strength over our flesh, we become better conduits for the expression of God and the divine flow is unabated. Saints, let us not relegate God to the dusty history books. His desire is for relationship with us, the apex of His creation. Through constant communion with Him, He will become a living reality in our lives, our ever present help in our time of trouble. Even in

He will never leave us nor forsake us.

*But I say to you, love your enemies, bless those who curse you, do good to those who hate you, and pray for those who spitefully use you and persecute you, **MATTHEW 5: 44 NKJV***

Brethren, how we eat is of as much gravity as what we eat. It does not suffice to just give, but Jesus requires that we do it cheerfully. The above instruction as recorded in the book of Matthew is humanly impossible to achieve without our Father. It is only when we abide in Him, die to self and allow Him to have free reign in us and through us that we can do the supernatural.

*Better is a dinner of herbs where love is, Than a fattened calf with hatred. **PROVERBS 15: 17 NKJV***

The food you eat is as important as the intention of preparation. As you are eating, you are also taking in everything that was declared on it. Daniel (please see Daniel 1), a man of great discernment, respectfully declined the choice meal from the king's table in favour of the lesser delectable vegetables and water. When we abide in our Lord Jesus Christ, we eat a sumptuous meal prepared with unconditional love. This meal liberates and does not enslave. If physical food can be programmed and manipulated, how much more, spiritual food? God requires that we have two essential ingredients in every undertaking; joy and love. The proof that we are a child of God is the love we walk in. The Agape love is the standard; it is selfless, sacrificial and unconditional. It is also impossible without the King of Kings as our dwelling place.

At that time they were running a Nursing staff agency business, at the same time They were doing some Nurse consultancy work in the Aged care space, Supporting Aged Care providers to back their compliance with the Aged care quality and commission. and men-

toring new managers into there are new roles. The home care business was a very closed area which they really wanted to be in but they did not have any clue of where to start. Deep inside of me was a word that kept coming to me, saying 'there has to be middle ground in aged Care'.

When Papa spoke, they received the word they believed it and started praying for God to order my steps.

In no time a senior colleague in the Aged Care industry and a regional manager of a large not for Profit organisation, called me randomly and asked me if They were doing anything at that time. She told me her organisation had Home Packages as part of their business and that part of the business was struggling to be profitable and she was wondering if they could come and help them out by providing leadership and mentoring to the whole team for 3 months.

They took up the three months contract and after the first three months

they asked me to renew the contract for another three months they asked me again to extend for another three months to make that nine months. They got to a point where at six months they really wanted to finish the contract and they remember coming to see Papa about it and Papa rebuked me gently, he said, "what if God wants you to be trained in that place? So, they quickly repented and went back and continued working in this contract which continued for a year and they received all the training they needed, full paid for while They were being paid as a consultant.

On one Friday evening in the power in his presence is Papa was teaching and preaching he called us all to come forward for prayer yes they were praying the word of God came down and he literally came to me and said franchise receive it and they received it with all my heart and all my being they actually remember falling down .

They continued to pray and thanking God for what he was doing in the back-

ground. Thanking him for the franchise business and continuing to ask God to continue to order our steps.

They did not have any money on us when they started looking for franchise businesses in the Home Care industry neither did, they have a strong borrowing power.

The franchises were quite expensive and in the natural it looked impossible, but God had everything planned and through the prophet of God, our father in the Lord, the blueprint of the business was released.

They remained connected and remained faithful, as Papa says, ‘When God speaks to you, it’s no longer about you, but about him, “the vision attracts the provision”’.

me, as he asked Moses, “what is in your hand? They had a property; a house and the instruction were to sell and release the equity that was sitting in the property and the rest God will direct.

They went home and told my husband, and the rest is history. The house sold at a record price and up to now our real Estate agent says he has never done an auction that went as ours did. There were angels in the auction room, and they believe they just took over.

When they had the money, they still had to wait on God’s direction on which franchise to buy, they continued praying and were actually turned down by the first two they approached, and one Saturday morning after an all-night prayer with Papa, they woke up with a very clear message on what to do, They were told to go to google and type in the words “Right at Home”. they did that and there, the franchise name came up, the rest is history, they bought two territories for the price of one.

The right at Home Franchise network is all over the world, Its HQ is in America and they had to go to America for training. They were the first ones to buy into this network apart from the master Franchise in Brisbane, now this network has grown to 30 offices all over Australia and the brand continues to grow stronger and stronger and this year is our fourth year in business to the glory of God.

There have been some major challenges along the way, but the God of Prophet Richard Amoaye has been faithful through and through.

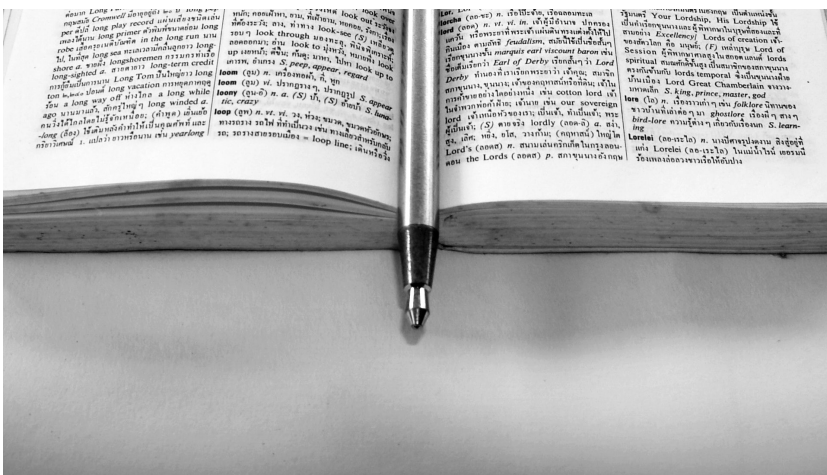
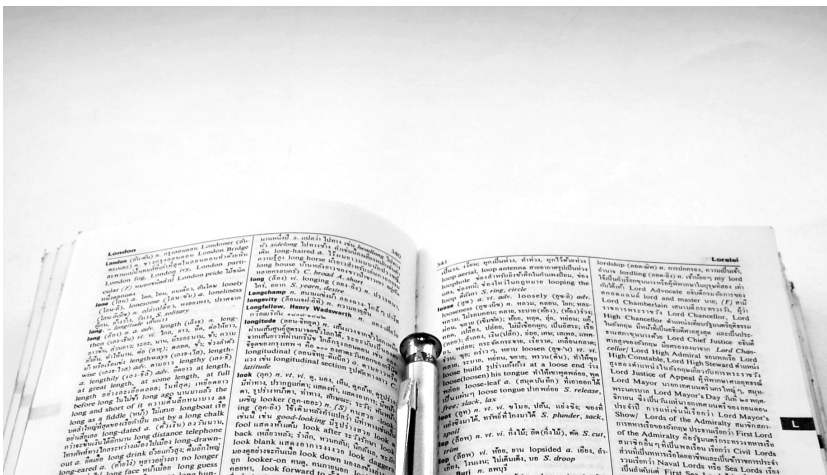

Matthew 4:4 reads "Man shall not live by bread alone, but by every word that proceeds from the mouth of God."

John 6:27 reads "Do not labor for the food which perishes, but for the food which endures to everlasting life, which the Son of Man will give you, because God the Father has set His seal on Him."

And John 6:63 reads "It is the Spirit who gives life; the flesh profits nothing. The words that I speak to you are spirit, and they are life."

These three scriptures confirm to us that from the mouth of God, comes the Word of God, which is the food of God and through its consumption we absorb its nutriments, having our spirits nourished.

To receive spiritual nourishment through The Word is to receive life and in receiving life, we obtain light. And with this light, we have the full assurance of good health both mentally and emotionally. This also guarantees our souls to rather find rest in Him when such times of uncertainty as these are near. Therefore, if spiritual nourishment is through feasting (reading, meditating and absorbing) on The Word of God then this supports:

Matthew 6:22 "The lamp of the body is the



eye. If therefore your eye is good, your whole body will be full of light.”

And Romans 12:2 “... be transformed by the renewing of your mind, that you may prove what is that good and acceptable and perfect will of God.”

Again, warranting a shift in perspective and wisdom from on high as to how to navigate and manoeuvre our way through.

Not only can food impact our lives by what we eat but our wellness is premised on our eating habits such as our consistency in keeping up with meals. To be nourished is one thing but receiving sustenance through food is another. It is through this that we receive energy and our source of strength to

function.

Let’s take a look at John 15:4-5

“Abide in Me, and I in you. As the branch cannot bear fruit of itself, unless it abides in the vine, neither can you, unless you abide in Me. I am the vine, you are the branches. He who abides in Me, and I in him, bears much fruit; for without Me you can do nothing.”

The word ‘abide’ connotes the idea of accepting or acting in accordance with (a rule, decision, or recommendation). It can also be defined as to ‘live’ or ‘dwell’. So, to abide in Him is a place of dwelling where we ought to continuously subscribe, follow and embrace all that Jesus offers without cessation.

Not sustaining the line of transferring information from The Word to ourselves can lead to us being weary and devoid of strength, for our fruitfulness (fruit being a metaphor to describe the outward demonstration of our inward disposition such as attitude, our behaviour, words and thoughts) is dependent on our connectivity to the branch. See it as skipping meals daily. The meals we skip contain calories being units of energy our body uses to function. So, there must be a continuous process in feeding on The Word.

In closing, our spiritual dietary requirements not only consist of being nourished through the Word of God but also having the appetite to receive sustenance from delighting in it.

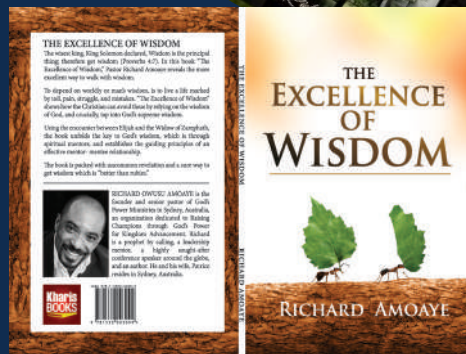

The book is packed with numerous illustrations and a new way to get wisdom which is "enter their mind".



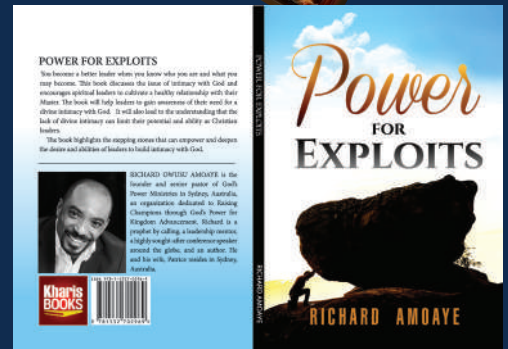
